While his parents and younger brother are Canadian citizens, Deepan lives an anguished life in a stateless limbo, without access to basic health and social services.

Deepan Budlakoti was born and raised in Ottawa. In his youth, he was issued several passports which identified him as a Canadian citizen.

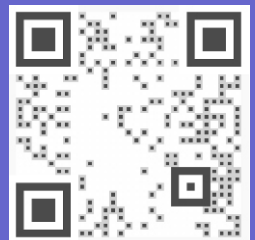
The Harper government has revoked his citizenship and is determined to deport him to India. But India won't issue him travel documents, considering him a Canadian citizen. India's High Commissioner confirmed Deepan's Canadian birth.



Join the Canadian Civil Liberties Association, Amnesty International, the Council of Canadians, the Canadian Labour Congress, CUPW, CUPE, and many others, in Deepan's struggle to regain his citizenship and remain with friends and family in his native Canada.

Deepan's case sets a precedent in the context of recently passed Bill C-24, which reforms the *Citizen Act*. Migrants and people of color have been and will continue to be targeted by racist and neo-colonial immigration laws and citizenship reforms.

Deepan studied at Laurentian University in the Law and Justice program, focusing on Human Rights and has extensive training and accreditation in worker safety. He is involved in the local activist community, working on his own case and that of others who are affected by the present government's repressive policies.
